Item I geve and bequeath to the poore of the said pish Twentie shillinges to be distributed amongst
 them at the tyme of my laste will. **Item** I geve and bequeath towards the amendinge of the Tower of
 S^t Mewan the some of one shillinge to be paid within one month after the said worke is begun.
Item I geve assigne and bequeath unto my some John Same The one halfe of my Tenement wherin
 I dwell and the moortie of my Tenement called Menarudock to have and to holde so him and his assigne
 duringe the Naturall life of Anne my wife. And the estate I have therein doe so longe continue, Tho
 said John and his assigne yeildinge and payinge the one halfe of all Rente suites and services due to
 the Lordes thereof. Prohibited alwayes that my wife shall have the said estate for the maintynance
 and education of my said some untill he shall accomplish the age of one and twentye yeeres. And my will
 and meaninge is that after the death of my wife my said some shall have both the said Tenements duringe the
 severall termes I have therein had then yeildinge and payinge the whole Rente and other duties thereout due
 and payablen. **Item** I further geve and bequeath unto my said some John Same The one halfe of my goodes
 and Chattells aswell within decodes as without (except the Tenement of the Princess and also wherin Fulpho
