That your Petitioner came into this Province in the Year 1793 with a wife and seven Children and received two hundred Acres in the Township of Pelham — That your Petitioner served last American War in the Jersey Volunteers, and was reduced with said Corps at the Reduction of 1783

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays your Honor would be pleased to allow him the residue of his Military Lands, and such Quantity for his Wife and Family as your Honor in your Wisdom may think proper, and your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray — Jonas Johnson
