 of Southwold an U.E. Loyalist. That your
 Petitioner is married to Robert Johnston
 of the Town of York, and having never
 received any Land or order for Land from
 the Crown your Petitioner humbly Prays
 that your Honor would be pleased to grant
 her 200 Acres as Daughter of an U.E. Loyalist
 and that her Husband may be authorized
 to locate the same when Agent and receive
 the Patent.

And your Petitioner shall ever
 pray -
 York 7th April 1810 -
 Margaret Johnston

Margaret Johnston wife of Robert Johnston of the
Town of York Carpenter maketh oath and saith
that she is the person she hath represented herself to be
in the within Petition and hath never received any land
from the Crown.

day; is recognized to be a daughter of Richard Lawrence
late of the Township of York who retained his loyalty during
the late war without suspicion of aiding or assisting the
Enemy; and that Robert Johnston her husband was
loyal and did his duty in defence of the Province during
the said late war.
