as a subject in the County has taken the Oath of Allegiance  
to His Majesty and has not heretofore received any Land or Order for  
Land from the Crown in any of His Majesty's Colonies, Your  
Petitioner therefore Humbly requests that Your Honour may  
be graciously pleas'd to Grant unto him such a portion of the  
Waste Land of the Crown as in Your Pleasure he Merits  
for which he is ready to pay the Fee - And he is in  
duty bound Your Honour's Petitioner will  
ever pray
