a wife & Two Children & your Petitioner
Robert Junior of a wife and one Child.

That they were granted in September 1817
Location as Settlers, Robert Senior the
last half of lot #. 22 in the 7th Concession
and Robert Junior the best half of the
same lot in the Township of Caubar as
will appear to your Excellency by the location
Ticket hereto annexed. That, intending

to have settled and commenced improving
their respective locations during the present
season they lately visited the same, but
found them so swampy as to be entirely
unfit for cultivation, for proof of which
unfitness your petitioners crave leave to
refer your Excellency to the accompanying
affidavit of Robert Johnson. Your
Petitioners therefore humbly pray Your
Excellency would be pleased to grant
them permission to receive other locations
in view of those above mentioned.
