The humble Petition of William Johnson of the Township
of Toronto.

Sheweth

That Your Petitioner is an Emigrant from England of good
Character and arrived in this Province with a Wife and one
Child in June 1818.

That on his arrival here he took the Lease of the Clergy
Reserve Aⁿ 2 in the 2nd Concession North of Dundas Street
in the Township of Toronto on which he now resides and
(assisted by his Brother) has made considerable Improvements
thereon.

That Your Petitioner having prayed Your Excellency in
Council on the 25th November last for permission to locate
his Right of Soil in the New Survey about to be made
in the said Township was then recommended for No. 100.
Your Petitioner humbly begs leave to represent to Your
Excellency that it would be attended with Considerable
inconvenience and loss were he to leave his present

Improvement to settle at a distance therefrom, and
prays that Your Excellency will be pleased to allow
him to locate his Right of Soil in the Rear, and
adjoining the Reserve, on which he has settled and
made Improvement.

Should it not seem meet to Your Excellency to grant
the foregoing prayer Your Petitioner prays that in
lieu thereof Your Excellency will be pleased to grant
him the Right of Inheritance to the said Reserve
on his paying down 126 Dollars being the amount
of the Rent for 21 Years: Or otherwise to grant
him a Lease for 99 Years of the said Reserve

And Your Petitioner as in duty bound

Shall ever pray.

The Jerry Reserve Lot No 2 in the
2nd Concession North of Grindstone
still in the Township of Toronto
has been granted as a place
to Wm. Johnson of Highbridge in
the Home District Teacher under
an Order in Council of 22 July 1818.

Wm. Johnson of Toronto, a
native of England was granted
by Governor in Council of 22 Nov^r 1818 100 acres not yet located.

When the Survey of the New
Township is examined there will
be land open for location next to
the Reserve granted to the Petitioner
but it is impossible to say
until the examination is made
how long the petitioner's several
persons located who have claimed
and for land in that part of the
Township.
