The humble Petition of Joseph Johnson of the Township
of Toronto.

Sheweth

That Your Petitioner was a Seaman in His
Majesty's Service on the Lakes and was discharged
therefrom in June 1817 when he received for
his Services a Location for 100 Acres of Land
in the Township of Brock — That Your
Petitioner after remaining 12 Months and making
considerable Improvements was obliged to abandon
the same his pecuniary means falling short.

That upon his leaving Brock he came to live with
his Brother William Johnson who had taken a Lot
of the Reserve No 2 in the 2^d Concessⁿ North Side of
Dundas Street in the Township of Toronto

That Your Petitioner being given to understand that
as an Englishman he is entitled to 100 Acres of
Land over and above the 100 Acres he received

for his Services in the Lakes humbly prays that
Your Excellency in Council will be pleased to allow him
to draw the same in the new Survey of the Township
of Toronto: And as Your Petitioner Brother William
Johnson (who petitioned Your Excellency in Council for
a Grant of Land in the said new Survey on the 23rd
November last) was then recommended to receive 100
Acres Your Petitioner humbly prays that Your
Excellency in Council will be pleased to allot him Land
adjoining to the said William Johnson

And Your Petitioner as in duty bound
shall ever pray.
