Russell offered for sale at 4/-  
which are now advertised for  
sale (and have been so since  
October 1844) at prices varying  
from 5/- to 8/- per acre.

The reduction in the price of  
the other lands to which he alludes  
was made upon ~~the~~ a representa-  
tion from the same gentleman  
and allowed under an order in  
Council of the 11<sup>th</sup> of October last.

The difference in the two cases  
is this. The lands for which  
a reduction in the price was  
made were the refuse of lots  
which had been advertised for  
sale at 8/- since the year 1839;  
whereas the lots to which refer-  
ence is now made are lands which  
were once under location and  
were resumed by the action of  
the Order in Council of the 14<sup>th</sup> of

April 1839 and were advertised for sale at prices suggested by the District Agent on inspection, to whose <sup>report</sup> reference is requested and sanctioned by the Executive Government on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 1844.

11<sup>th</sup> October 1844

Although the lands have been advertised for sale nearly seven years, it will be observed upon reference to the accompanying copy of the advertisement that very few lots have been sold. Taking this into consideration in conjunction with the circumstances of the lands having been abandoned by the locatees, it may be presumed that they are of an inferior quality. It is therefore recommended that this application be favorably entertained and that the land be opened for sale at 4/ per acre after a notice of 30 days.
