The Petition of John Johnson late Soldier in the Second
Battalion of Royal Fusiliers commanded by M^r John
Johnson Capt.

Humbly Sheweth -

That he has served his Majesty fifteen years
in the several last Wars - and has not yet received
any Lands from Government.

That he did Draw Lot N^o 14th on the River -
- reason. which was after given into Possession of another
person. as will appear by the Certificate here enclosed.
from W^m Falkner Esq.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays
you will please to take his case into
consideration. and give such Directions
that he may receive whatever Lands
he may be found entitled to; both
as Bounty from the Crown. and as
Bounty from the Right Honorable
Guy Lord Dorchester.
