I Certify that the signature of John Johnston of the Canadian Fencible who acted as Adjutant to the Militia on duty at the Post of York from the 25th of October 1812 to the 24th of January 1813 inclusive under my Command could not be obtained as a Witness to the Affidavits annexed to the Accounts of the Paymaster to the said Militia for the period above mentioned by reason of his being in a distant part of the Province at the time the said Affidavits were made.
