is the daughter of Thomas Lake of the aforesaid Township  
of Wolford a Loyalist who adhered to the Unity of the  
Empire and joined the Royal Standard before the year  
1783 that your petitioner is married and has not  
hitherto received any land or order for lands from  
the Crown - she therefore prays your Excellency in  
Council will please to grant her hundred acres of the  
wast lands of the Crown and beyond Mr Thomas Mc  
Cua of the Township of Montague to locate and take  
out the said for the same
