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To His Excellency Francis Gore Esquire. Lieutenant 18th
Governor of the Province of Upper Canada in Council +
The Petition of Christopher Lake of the Township
of Innes Town in the Midland District Yeoman
Humbly Sheweth

That Your Petitioner and family have con-
stantly resided in this Province since the Year 1795 That
Your Petitioner Served in Burgoyne's Campaign in the
Year 1777 and was taken prisoner a few days before
the Convention at Saratoga That Your Petitioner
disturbed Circumstances prevented him from coming
into this Province at an earlier period That Your Petitioner's
Family consists of Seven Children the youngest being
now of the Age of Sixteen Years Your Petitioner therefore
humbly prays Your Excellency would be pleased to grant
him the additional Quantity of Lands as a
Military Claimant with his Family Lands —
Christopher Lake

And Your Petitioner beg leave to state to Your
Excellency that he heretofore petitioned for his
Family Lands and they were not granted for
want of Proof of his family Your Petitioner therefore
prays that his former Petition may be revised
and that his family Lands and the additional
Lands as a Military Claimant may be granted
him
