The Petition of James Lake, Son of
Thomas and Michel Lake of the Town of Wolford
and District of Johnstown. U.C. is of the full Age of
Twenty One Years and Upwards and has only drawn
One Hundred Acres of Land which was then allotted
to all Children of Actual Settlers. Therefore Your
Petitioner Humbly Prayeth if your Excellency
shall think fit to grant them a portion of the
Waste Land of the Crown of Great Britain
and therefore Prayeth that Your Excellency in
Council will Allow the same and Your Petitioner
- or as in Duty Bound will Ever Pray
