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To His Excellency Francis Gore Esquire, Lieutenant Governor
of the Province of Upper Canada—&c—&c—&c.

In Council.

The Petition of John Lake— of the Township of Sidney
Humbly sheweth That Your Petitioner is the son of Nicholas
Lake— of the said Township a U.C. Loyalist, and has
Arrived to the age of Twenty One Years, and has taken the Oath
of Allegiance as will appear by the annexed Certificate
and has Never Received any land or Order for Land from
the Crown. Wherefore Your Petitioner prays that Your
Excellency may be pleased to Grant him Two hundred Acres
of the Waste Lands of the Crown, and Permit John Dutton
of the Town of York to be his Agent to Locate and take
out the Deed when Completed. And Petitioner as in
