 THE PETITION OF James Lake of the Township of
Sydney in the Midland District, and Province of Upper Canada, Humbly
 sheweth, that your Petitioner is the Son of Late Nicholas Lake
 of the Township of Sydney in the aforsaid District, a
 U. E. Loyalist; that your Petitioner has attained the age twenty-one years, and has taken
 the oath of allegiance, as appears by the annexed Certificate; and has never received any
 Land or order for Land from the Crown: Your Petitioner, therefore, prays that your
Honor will be pleased to grant him two hundred acres of the waste
 Lands of the Crown and permit Patrick Strange of York to locate
 the same and take out the Deed when completed. And as in duty bound will ever pray.

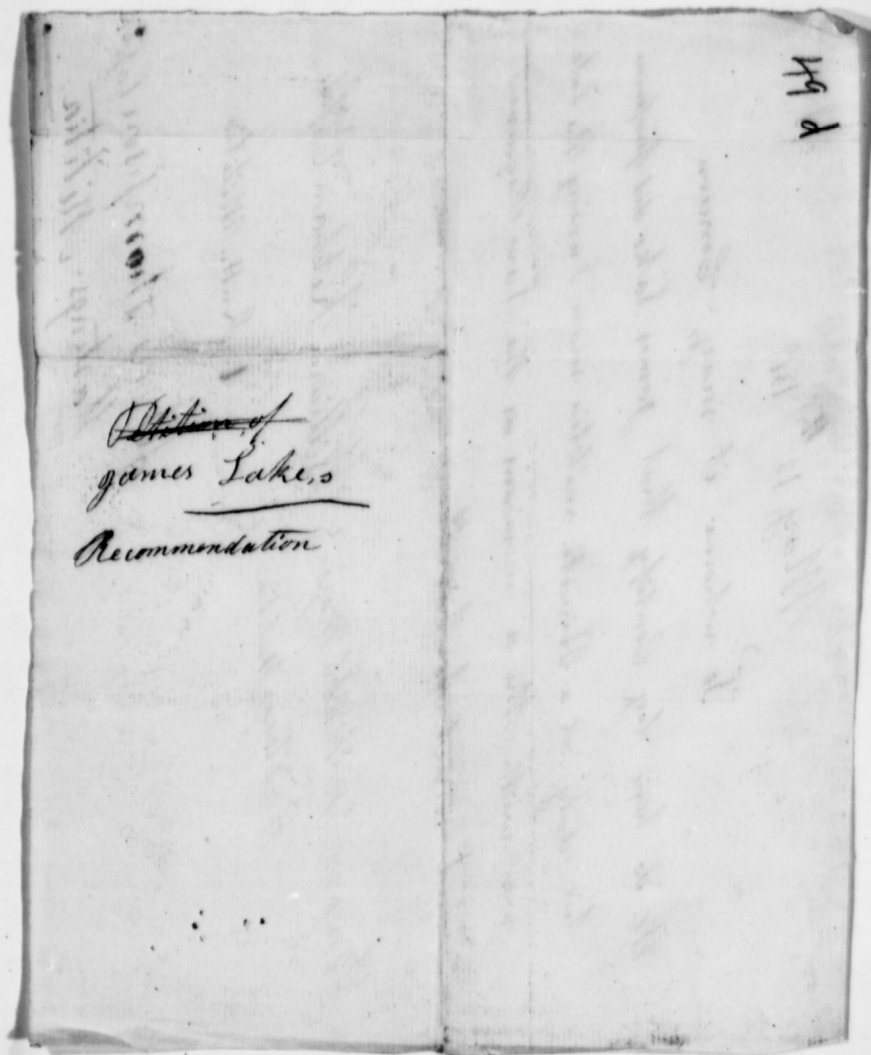
