Canada Land Petitions "L" Bundle 9, 1803-1810

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To his Excellency Francis Gore Esquire Lieutenant
Governor of the Province of Upper Canada 1808

In Council

The Petitioner James Lake of the Township of Earnest
town Youman Humbly sheweth

That your Petitioner is the son of James Lake
of the Township of Earnest town U. C. loyalist that he has attained
the full age of twenty one years has taken the Oath of Allegiance
as will appear by the annexed certificate and has never received
any land or order for land from the Crown

Wherefore your Petitioner prays that your Excellency
may be pleased to grant him two hundred acres of the waste
lands of the Crown and permit M^r John Durbles of the town
of York to be his Agent to locate the same and take out the deed

And your Petitioner is in duty bound to swear
Adolphus town James Lake June 24th
January 24th 1809

James Lake maketh Oath and
swath that he is the person he describes himself to be in the above
Petition that he has attained the full age of twenty one years
and has never received any land or order for land from the Crown
