grant *him* Two Hundred Acres of the waste Lands of the Crown, and permit  
CHARLES BAYNES of the Town of York, Gentleman, to be *his* Agent, to Locate  
the same and take out the Deed when completed.—And your Petitioner as in duty bound  
will ever Pray.
