of the said Ship, having acted in the Capacity of Captain's
Clerk, He has been discharged from His Majesty's
Service, and is now keeping School in the Township
of Ernest-Town and intends to remain in the
Country as an actual Settler.

a grant of land as your Excellency may think fit and
permit. A. Munro of York to locate the same and take out
the Deed when completed
