The Petition of *Margaret Lake* of the Township of *Adolphus Town* in the *Midland* District, Province of Upper Canada, humbly sheweth that your Petitioner is the daughter of *Daniel Fraser* of the Township of *Adolphus Town* in the *Midland* District, a U. E. LOYALIST, and the wife of *Daniel Parrot Lake* of the Township of *Adolphus Town*. That your petitioner is married and has never received any Land or order for Land from the Crown. Your Petitioner therefore prays that your *Willingness* will be pleased to grant unto her two hundred acres of the waste lands of the Crown, and permit to be her Agent to locate the same, and to receive the Patent when completed. And as in duty bound will ever pray.
