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To His Excellency Sir Charles Bagot
Governor General of the Province of Can.
A.D. 1842

The petition of Nicholas Lake of Kawartha in the
District of Peterborough and Province of Canada
Gentlemen: Humbly sheweth that he is the only
son and heir at law of Richard Lake late of said
Township of Kawartha deceased, that said Richard
Lake died in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eighty Four hundred and Sixty five, and made a will
which will is not executed, but in said will he
bequeathed to his dependant all his real estate, but no
mention was made in said will to his right to two
hundred acres of land as the son of Nicholas Lake a
W. E. Loutrel. That your petitioner has
claimed his right to said two hundred acres
of land to Edmund Murray of Bellville Esquire
Your petitioner therefore prays Your Excellency
that his claim may pass the council for
and in the behalf of the said Edmund Murray
And your petitioner as in duty bound will ever
pray -
