I have the honor to state
that it is only now I am enabled
to Report on and return the Petitions
of Peter Lake and Thomas Griffith
for permission to purchase Clergy Reserve
No. 5 in 6th Con. Ramsay. Jacob
Lake who petitioned in the year 1842
is father to Peter Lake and father in law
to Thomas Griffith they have left
in this Office his resignation in their
favor and an affidavit that Jacob
Lake has occupied the lot fifteen
years. I have no doubt that Mr
Carr's valuation is correct but
they are aware they will have to
pay 8/ per acre.

At the request of Mr Peter Lake I have surveyed and examined the west half of Lot number five in the sixth Concession of the Township of Ramsey and find it to be mostly composed or covered with flat free stone flags one row above another it will be very hard either to plough or harrow any of it the land is worth no more than six shillings and six pence per acre There is about twenty five acres of improvement upon said Lot a house and small barn it has been in possession about four years by Jacob Lake who has given his claim to the above Peter Lake
