The Petition of John Lake, now of the
Town of York, Farmer, and Discharged Soldier,
Humbly Sheweth

That your Petitioner is a native of
Oxford in England, that he was discharged from
His Majesty's 37th Regiment, in this Province in
April 1818, that he is desirous of settling
upon the Crown ^{Reversion} Lot Number seventeen in
the second Concession north of Dundas Street
in the Township of Trafalgar, old Sebewoy,
and that he has taken the oath of Allegiance
required by Law.

Wherefore your Petitioner humbly
prays that your Excellency may be pleased
to grant him a Lease of the said Lot, under the
existing Regulations and on the usual conditions:
and your Petitioner respectfully names Barnaby
Deane of the same Township Yeoman as a
surety for the due payment of the Rents,
and performance of the conditions of the Lease.
Should your Excellency be pleased to grant the
prayer of this Petition.
