That Your Petitioner is a farmer and
has cultivated land in this Township -
has taken the Oath of Allegiance and
retained his loyalty & did all duty
required of him, during the late War

as will appear by a Certificate attached
to his Petition for a further grant of land
that your Petitioner is now 56 years
of age, and has a large family is therefore
desirous of leasing the residue of the
lot in the 15th Concession of Ernest Town
wherefore your Petitioner humbly
Prays that your Excellency in Council
would be pleased to grant him a
lease of the said lot - and should
the Prayer of his Petition be
favourably answered he begs leave
to offer James Lake ^{the eldest son of} ~~of the said~~
Township of Ernest Town as surety
to be joined in bonds with your Petitioner
to secure the regular payment of the
rent according to the tenure of the
said lease And as in duty bound
