The Petition of Sarah Reed wife of Solomon Reed
of the Township of Thurlow in the County of Hastings in
the Midland District and daughter of the late Nicho-
las Lake of Thurlow aforesaid an U.E. Loyalist.

Thumblly sheweth

That your Petitioner is of age and Married and
has never rec^d. any Lands from the Crown.

Wherefore your

petitioner prays that your Excellency will be pleased
to Grant her Two hundred acres of Land of the waste
Lands of the Crown as the daughter of an U.E.
Loyalist and your petitioner as in duty Bound
will ever pray
