The Petition of Michael Root of the Township
 of Loughborough Esquire a U.-C. Loyalist.

Humbly Sheweth

That your Petitioner was born in the Late Province
 of New York. that in the year 1776 he joined the
 Royal army and continued in the service untill the
 Peace of 1783. that he came to this Province in the
 year 1786. and settled in the Township of Adolphustown
 where your Petitioner made valuable improvements
 and Buildings and resided untill the year 1807.
 when a Settlement was Commencing in the Township
 of Loughborough. that being desirous to Promote
 the Settlement he sold his Property in the Township
 of Adolphustown. removed to Loughborough and
 erected Mills for the accomodation of the settlers
 which tended much to the Benefit and Increase of
 the same. that your Petitioner has ever endeavor-
 ed to Inculcate a spirit of Loyalty Industry
 and good order among the Inhabitants. and to
 render himself a usefull subject.

That owing to various Circumstances growing
 out of the Late war your Petitioner has sustained

Loses to a Large amount in his Business.
which has Induced him to approach your Excellency
and pray that your Excellency will be pleased
in Consideration of his Services and Losses to
Grant him such quantity of the waste Lands
of the Crown as your Excellency in your wisdom
shall deem meet.

My Dear Sir

The Bearer Mr. Stoot a Magistrate of the Midland District is about leaving this part of the Country and intends I believe settling in the London or Western District he has been unfortunate in his Location of Lands being reported unfit for Cultivation he has surrounded his Gravel and is desirous of obtaining Lands in the London or Western District in lieu thereof After improving a farm in Adolphus Town he sold the same and ventured into the Woods back of Kingston about Twenty Miles where he has improved a very fine farm of about 150 Acres of improvement with a good frame house and frame Barn from their Exertion a very nice settlement has been formed from Mr. Stoot being the only settler their Numbers have increased to between 70 and eighty from Embarrassments he is obliged to sell

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his Property as I am aware of his Intentions -
in forming this Settlement and making a Road
for his first establishment down into the Woods
if he could be favoured with a Location in the
New Township in the London District performing
the Settlement duties in lieu of the Lands -
he has surrendered to the Crown it might
save his comforts in the latter part of
life he has a strong family about seven or
eight in number.
