executors administrators or assigns, shall make and execute or cause to be made and
executed a good and sufficient Deed of bargain and sale in fee simple, free of all incum-
brances, to the above named Benjamin Sequeson his heirs, executors,
administrators, and assigns for such two hundred acres of land as have been, may or shall
be granted to me as the a Militiaman during the of a U. E. Loyalist. Upon the
issuing of the King's patent for the said land, at the request of the said Benjamin
Sequeson his certain attorney or attorneys, his heirs executors administra-
tors or assigns. Then this obligation to be null and void, and of no effect, otherwise to
remain in full force virtue and effect. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
