 Province, to be paid unto the said Benjamin Seguier his
 certain attorney or attorneys, executors administrators or assigns, for which payment
 well and truly to be made I bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators firmly by
 these presents. Sealed with my seal and dated the Twentieth day of October
 in the years of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four.

Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden
James Lake Jr. his certain attorney or attorneys,
 executors administrators or assigns, shall make and execute or cause to be made and
 executed a good and sufficient Deed of bargain and sale in fee simple, free of all incum-
 brances, to the above named Benjamin Seguier his heirs, executors,
 administrators, and assigns for such two hundred acres of land as have been, may or shall
 be granted to me as the ^a Militiaman during the ^{late} ^{year} of a U. E. Loyalist. Upon the
 issuing of the King's patent for the said land, at the request of the said Benjamin
Seguier his certain attorney or attorneys, his heirs executors administra-
 tors or assigns. Then this obligation to be null and void, and of no effect, otherwise to
 remain in full force virtue and effect. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this ^{Twentieth} day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hund-
 red and ^{thirty} four.
