that Elizabeth Walker personally appeared
before the General Session of the
Peace of the said District this day
and is recognized by the Magistrate to be
the daughter of Christopher Lake deceased
formerly of Cranstown in the Midland District
a U^l Loyalist that the said Christopher Lake
retained his loyalty during the late war without
suspicion of aiding or assisting the Enemy
and that he has ~~been~~ ^{performed} his duty to the defence of the
Province during the late war
