

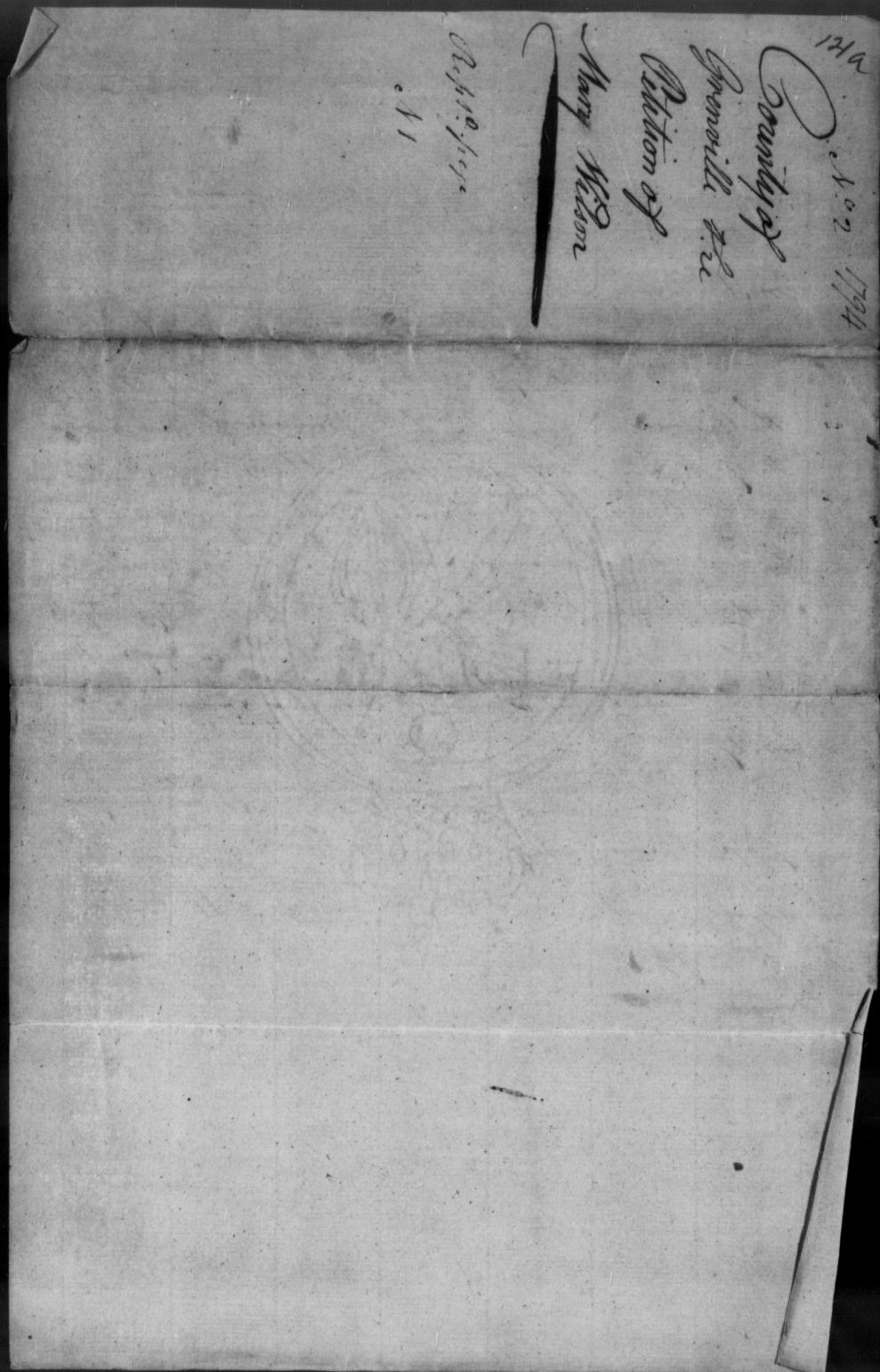
To His Excellency the Governor in Council
