JOHNSON, RICHARD DIGBY. Rank, Major, Royal Dublin Fusiliers, 3rd Batt.; killed in action, May 24, 1915.

JOHNSON, ROBERT. Royal Air Force; died, military hospital, Blandford, Dorsetshire, November 12, 1918.

JOHNSON, SAMUEL. Reg. No. 2989. Rank, Rifleman, King's Royal Rifle Corps, 1st Batt.; died, France, March 6, 1915; born Belfast.

JOHNSON, SAMUEL FYNNEY. Reg. No. 60862. Rank, Private, Northumberland Fusiliers (Tyneside Irish) formerly West Yorkshire Regiment; died, France, July 13, 1918; born Cardiff.

JOHNSON, SIDNEY ERNEST. Reg. No. 608748. Rank, Corporal, 18th London Regiment, (London Irish Rifles) formerly 8th London Regiment; died of wounds, France, May 30, 1918; born Harlesden.

JOHNSON, TED. Regimental No. 4654. Rank, Private, Connaught Rangers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, September 9, 1915; born Hornsey, Middlesex.

JOHNSON, THOMAS. Reg. No. 8512. Rank, Private, 1st Royal Dublin Fusiliers; killed in action, Gallipoli, May 2, 1915; born Drogneda. JOHNSON, THOMAS. Reg. No. 26/367. Rank, Private, Northumberland Fusiliers (Tyneside Irish); killed in action, France, July 1, 1916; born Chester-le-Street, Durham.

JOHNSON, WILFRED. Reg. No. 25/1030. Rank, Private, Northumberland Fusiliers (Tyneside Irish); died France, July 8, 1916; born Chester-le-Street, Durham.

JOHNSON, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 19171. Rank, Private, Northumberland Fusiliers (Tyneside Irish); died, France, April 28, 1917; born Knottingley.

JOHNSON, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 2355/1. Rank, Private, 1st Royal Dublin Fusiliers; killed in action, France, October 20, 1916; born Liverpool.

JOHNSTONE, SAMUEL. Reg. No. 540. Rank, Private, Highland Light Infantry, 10/11th Batt.; died of wounds, France, September 6, 1916; born Farntown, Co. Armagh.

JOHNSTONE, THOMAS. Reg. No. S/10892. Rank, Private, East Kent Regiment, 1st Batt.; died of wounds, France, February 24, 1915; born Rathmines, Co. Dublin.

JOHNSTONE, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 1081. Rank, Sergeant, 4th (Royal Irish) Dragoon Guards; killed in action, France, October 28, 1914; born Kirkguneon, Kirkcudbright.

JOHNSTONE, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 25412. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Regiment, 7th Batt.; killed in action, France, March 21, 1918; born Grangegorman, Co. Dublin.

JOHNSTONE, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 47658. Rank, Private, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, October 15, 1918; born Govan Hill, Lanark-

JOHNSTONE, WILLIAM HENRY. Reg. No. 17985. Rank, Private, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, January 27, 1917; born Fiverniletown, Co. Tyrone.

JOINT, CHARLES HENRY. Reg. No. 50038. Rank, Rifleman, 1/18th London Regiment (Royal Irish Rifles); killed in action, France, September 5, 1918; born Wyborough, Devonshire.

JOISE, JOHN. Reg. No. 3198. Rank, Private, Connaught Rangers; killed in action, France, August 19, 1915; born Galway; age 32.

JOLLEY, JEFFREY. Reg. No. 1950. Rank, Corporal, Royal Munster Fusiliers, 2nd Batt.; killed in action, France, June 17, 1916; born Wigan, Lancashire.

JOLLY, ANDREW GORDON. Reg. No. G/4782. Rank, Lance-Corporal, The Royal Sussex Regiment, 4th Batt.; killed in action, British Expeditionary Force, July 29, 1918; born Duncannon Fort, Co. Waterford.

JOLLY, THOMAS. Reg. No. 7116. Rank, Private, Irish Guards, 2nd Batt.; killed in action, France, September 27, 1915; born Kiltoom, Co. Roscommon.

JONAS, JOHN. Reg. No. 13569. Rank, Private, 6th Royal Irish Fusiliers; killed in action, Gallipoli, August 9, 1915; born Cardiff, Glamorganshire.

JONES, ALBERT. Reg. No. 41964-Rank, Private, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, 8th Batt.; killed in action, France, August 16, 1917.

JONES, ALEC FRANCIS. Reg. No. 3047. Rank, Staff Quartermaster Sergenant, 4th (Royal Irish) Dragoon Guards; died, France, November 6, 1914; born Plumstead, Kent; decoration, M.S.M.

JONES, ALEXANDER. Reg. No. 16641. Rank, Rifleman, 13th Royal Irish Rifles; killed in action, France, June 28, 1916; born Dromore, Co. Down.
